

Veolia Water Projects Limited Household Charges Scheme 2023/24 Statement regarding the Board's assessment of bill increases for 2023/24

The Board of Veolia Water Projects Limited (the "Company") has noted the requirements under A1 of Ofwat's Charges Scheme rules with respect to the approval of the impact assessments and handling strategies developed in instances where bill increases for licensees exceed 5%.

Members of the Board reviewed all proposed changes in charges compared to the previous charging year and considered how these translated into typical household customers' bills.

The Board has assessed the Statements of Assurance provided by Wessex Water and Southern Water and expects household charges to increase by more than 5% due to the high rate of inflation (November CPIH figure reached 9.3%):

- Ex-Southern Water typical household water bills are projected to increase by 9% in average and typical household wastewater charges are projected to increase by 9.7% in average
- Ex-Wessex Water typical household water bills are projected to increase by 10.9% in average and typical household wastewater charges are projected to increase by 6.6% in average

We have developed a customer communication strategy to mitigate the impacts of the greater than 5% increase in bills.
