







Keeping everyone informed:

This issue of the North Quay Energy Recovery Facility (ERF) Bulletin has been produced to keep you up to date with activities on the site in Newhaven.

Annual maintenance outage

Throughout the months of July and August 2016 Veolia's Annual Maintenance Outage will take place on site at the ERF. Waste will continue to be delivered, although in reduced amounts as the plant will not be running at full capacity as normal. This will include a period where we will not export electricity to the National Grid to allow for essential safety maintenance to be conducted.

Operations on site during outage

Numerous improvements and tests will be taking place on site including:

Noise Management: Monitoring will be undertaken to ensure low levels of noise during operation.

Air Cooled Condenser (ACC): High pressure water washing of the panels will be undertaken to maintain ACC efficiency and power generation.

ERF Equipment: All equipment will be fully serviced and cleaned including the boiler and grate.

Roof: Installing additional mesh – at this time you may see people on the roof. This will also be happening at other times during the year.

Pressurised Steam System: Safety regulation checks of the high pressure steam and water cycle systems will be completed to ensure everything is compliant and safe to continuously operate.

Chimney: Safety inspections on the chimney stacks - at this time you may see steeplejacks climbing up or down chimney stacks; this is normal and part of the checks that need to take place during the outage.

Boilers: Maintenance to the boilers will be taking place throughout July - during this time you may hear a slight increase in noise coming from the ERF – this is normal and part of the outage process.

What's happening in July and August?

Event	Activity on site
Installing additional mesh to roof	People on the roof
Chimney checks	Steeplejacks visible on the chimneys
Boiler Maintenance	Possibility of hearing more noise than usual from the ERF
