## Did You Know?

Horse drawn open backed carts were the first collection vehicles used back in 1875. These were followed by steam driven trucks before mechanical trucks were invented.



Today's recycling collection vehicles are based on an original design from the 1929 'Heil Collecto-Pak'.

There are lots of levers and hydraulic cylinders that lift, compact and eject the recycling.

Why not make your own recycling collection vehicle with this activity. There are 2 templates to choose from.

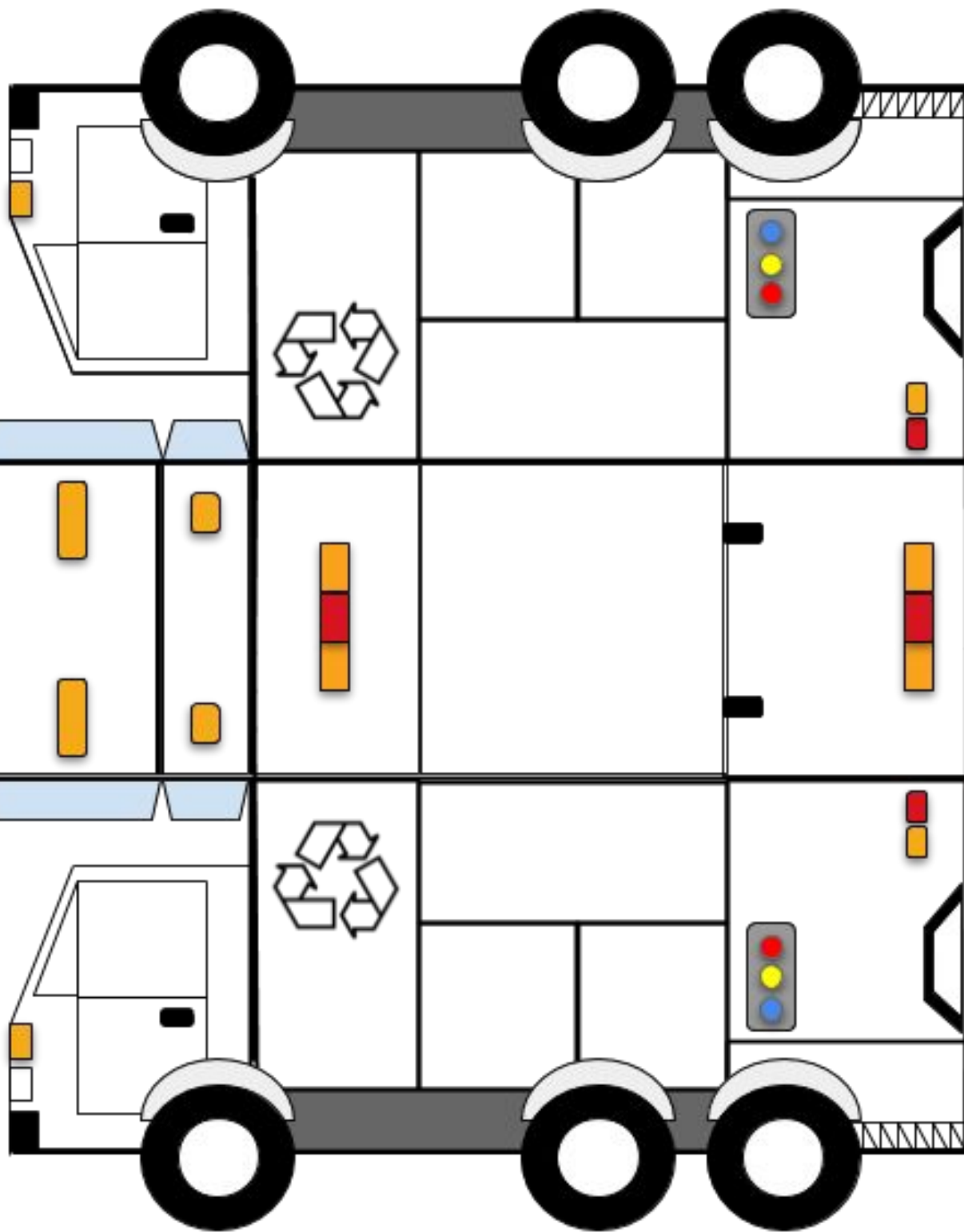
### You Will Need:

Glue



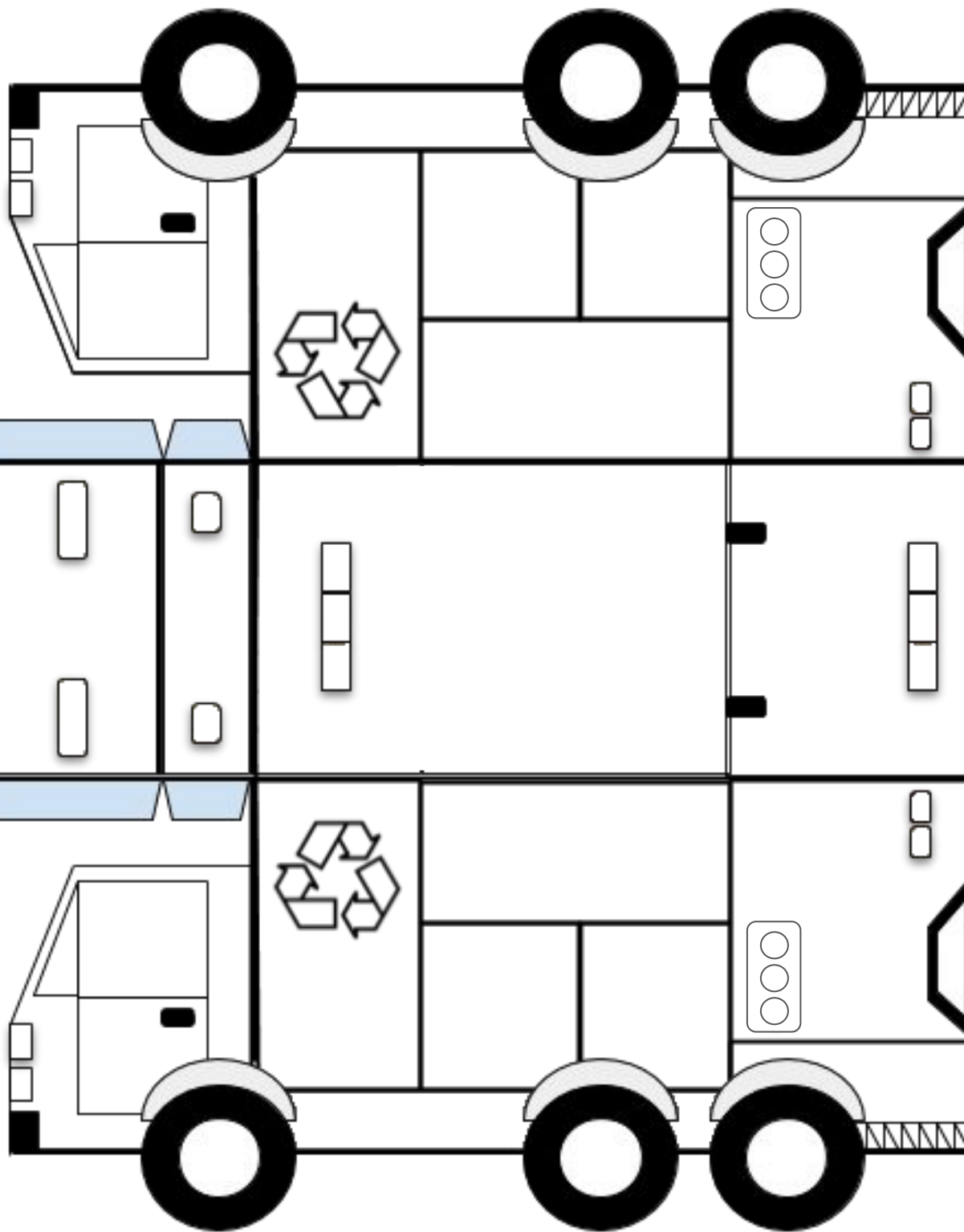


What to do:
