Draft Drought Management Plan 2017

Public Consultation Deadline 30/04/18

Our draft drought management plan sets out how we will meet the challenges of an extended period of high demand.

We have reviewed and updated this plan and produced a new draft, following guidance provided by the Environment Agency, our environmental regulator in accordance with section 37B of the Water Act, and regulations 2 and 3 of the Drought Plan Regulations 2005.

There have been some redactions on the grounds of national security. These relate to expressing site names as site letter codes and the removal of two maps (item 1.3.1 a map of the ground water safety zone and 1.3.2 a map of the distribution system).

The new draft has been published for public consultation up until 30/04/18.

Following public consultation, we will produce a statement of response which shows the comments we received during consultation and how we have used these comments to produce our final draft drought plan.
