Subject: Veolia Water Projects Limited 2020 draft Drought Management Plan - call for pre-consultation

Following guidance from the Environment Agency and in accordance with section 37B of the Water Act, and regulations 2 and 3 of the Drought Plan Regulations 2005, Veolia Water Projects Limited has reviewed its Drought Management Plan.

This plan sets out the actions we will take before, during and after a drought to maintain a secure supply of water to our customers. It also sets out how we will assess the environmental effects of our actions to maintain supply and what we will do to mitigate damage.

From this review, a new draft - *June 2020 Draft Drought Management Plan* - has been produced and published for public pre-consultation. You are now invited to review the document and share your comments until September 30th, 2020.

Following the pre-consultation, we will produce a statement of response which will show the comments we received during consultation and how we have used these comments to produce our final draft drought management plan.
