Subject: Veolia Water Projects Limited 2022 Drought Management Plan

Following guidance from the Environment Agency and in accordance with section 37B of the Water Act, and regulations 2 and 3 of the Drought Plan Regulations 2005, Veolia Water Projects Limited has reviewed its Drought Management Plan.

This plan sets out the actions we will take before, during and after a drought to maintain a secure supply of water to our customers. It also sets out how we will assess the environmental effects of our actions to maintain supply and what we will do to mitigate damage.

From this review, a draft was produced and published for public consultation. Following the consultation, we have produced a statement of response. A final draft drought management plan was submitted to Defra for approval in April 2022 and we have now been authorised to publish the VWPL 2022 Drought Plan.

The 2022 VWPL Drought Plan will be available on our website at www.veolia.co.uk/tidworth-operations and does not contain sensitive information in relation to national security and has not been redacted.

A revised plan will be produced within five years from the date of the publication of this plan.
