The story so far...

In January 2012 Veolia were awarded planning permission to build and operate a brand new Energy Recovery Facility (ERF) in partnership with Shropshire Council.


This new facility will be built next to the existing Household Recycling Centre and Transfer Station at Battlefield Enterprise Park, Vanguard Way, Shrewsbury.

The ERF will divert 90,000 tonnes of waste every year from landfill and produce enough electricity to power 10,000 homes.

Our plans for the Shropshire ERF are based on the amount of waste produced and anticipated increases in recycling and composting rates.

Community Liaison

We have established a Community Liaison Group. This group is made up of local people who will meet on a regular basis. The group is expected to meet in October and they will be given a full update on work so far.

The minutes of all the Community Liaison meetings will be published on our website along with copies of all the information leaflets. The group will continue to meet throughout the construction period and once the facility is fully operational.

The next stage

Since gaining planning permission a considerable amount of work has been going on behind the scenes.

Our main construction contractor CNIM Clugston has been completing the detailed design works and submissions to Shropshire Council to comply with the planning conditions that must be met before work can start.

These have been completed and approved. It is hoped that construction will begin during October 2012.

This will include:

- Construction cabins arriving on site
- Civil engineering and ground works will begin.
