

Terms and conditions

1. Groups must be properly constituted not-for-profits to apply. This is a group with a constitution that states they are a not-for-profit. Groups must provide a copy of a recent bank statement to prove this. A copy of your constitution may be requested.
2. For Sports Funding, groups must be affiliated to a Sport England recognised governing body.
3. Groups must have been established for a minimum of 12 months.
4. Decisions on the success of applications and the amount of funding granted is final - correspondence will not be entered into.
5. The application form must be fully completed and all applications must be supported by detailed quotes for any planned work, material purchases and/or detailed breakdowns of other planned expenditure.
6. Applications requiring funding from other sources in order to carry out the project will need to provide written proof that they have either been awarded or will be awarded that funding prior to EnviroGrant/Sports Funding grants funding being given. Or give full details on their application.
7. Groups are required to use the funding within a year of receiving it, and keep Veolia informed of significant milestones in the project. If the situation occurs where the project may over-run beyond a year please contact us to discuss.
8. Groups are required to complete a funding evidence form and provide receipts to show proof of spending within a year of receiving the grant.
9. Acknowledgement of Veolia Telford and Wrekin EnviroGrant/Sports Funding scheme to be included with any publicity about the project. This is to include logos on all promotional materials associated with the project. We will provide logos electronically for this purpose.
10. A member of staff from Veolia must be allowed to visit or to see the activities of the project (to be coordinated at a suitable time and date).
11. Grants should not be used for any purpose other than the project as outlined in your application. Veolia reserves the right to seek repayment of the grant if any part of it is not used for the given purpose.
12. Projects will be evaluated against their benefits to the local environment and community.
13. Projects must be located in Telford and Wrekin.
14. Successful applicants cannot apply in consecutive years.
15. Veolia and Telford & Wrekin Council will be able to promote and publicise the group's project activities. You will be required to complete a publicity information form for this purpose.
16. Acknowledgment of Veolia working with Telford & Wrekin Council, and the grant must be made on all promotional material associated with the project. We will provide publicity information for this purpose. Sign-off for use of logos must be sought before distribution.
17. Grants can only be paid into the bank account of the organisation, not that of a private individual.

EnviroGrant and Sports Funding schemes

Does your community group make a positive difference to the local community or environment? If the answer is yes, the Veolia Telford and Wrekin EnviroGrant and Sports Funding schemes may be able to help you.

Grants are available to community groups in the borough of Telford and Wrekin for projects that benefit the local community or the environment. We also have the Sports Funding grant specifically for local sports clubs.

What are the EnviroGrant and Sports Funding schemes?

The EnviroGrant and Sports Funding schemes are run by recycling contractor Veolia in conjunction with Telford & Wrekin Council; it is part of the added value brought to the borough by Veolia.

Who can apply?

To apply, groups must be properly constituted not-for-profit organisations in the borough of Telford and Wrekin. Please see the terms and conditions for more details relating to the grant.

What are the grants for and how much can be applied for?

EnviroGrant gives grants of up to £1000 for projects that benefit the local community or the environment. This could be projects that improve

or protect the local environment through practical action or education, or projects that improve the quality of life for the local community by providing or improving facilities and resources.

The **Sports Funding** gives grants of up to £250 for Sport England affiliated sports groups, for projects that provide a long-term benefit to the club and provide opportunities for the wider community.
